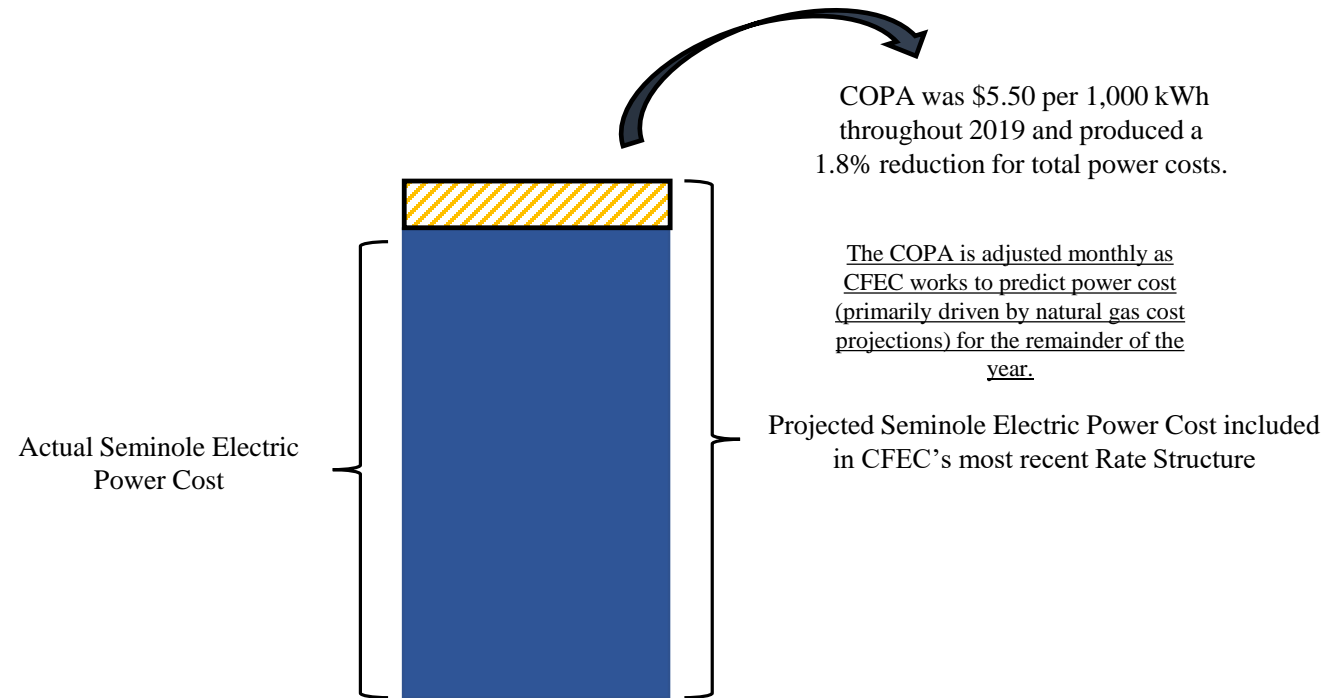


What is the Cost of Power Adjustment (COPA)?

The COPA is used to “adjust” the amount charged to members when the price of fuels to generate electricity, rise and fall over time. Fuel cost adjustments can be additions or subtractions on your bill, depending on how much Central Florida Electric’s wholesale power provider, (Seminole Electric Cooperative) had to pay for generation fuels.



$$\text{COPA} = \text{Projected Power Cost} \pm \text{The Actual Power Cost}$$
